## *Research Funding Opportunities*

### **Predocctoral Fellowship**

To help students initiate careers in cardiovascular and stroke research by providing research assistance and training.

### **Postdoctoral Fellowship**

To help M.D. or Ph.D. trainees initiate a career in cardiovascular and stroke research while obtaining significant research results.

### **Fellow-to-Faculty Transition Award**

To provide funding for beginning physician-scientists with outstanding potential for careers in cardiovascular and stroke research. Supports the crucial period of career development spanning the completion of research training through the early years of the first faculty/staff position.

### **Scientist Development Grant**

To support highly promising beginning scientists in their progress toward independence; bridges the gap between completion of research training and readiness for successful competition as an independent investigator.

### **Beginning Grant-in-Aid**

To promote the independent status of promising beginning scientists.

### **Established Investigator Award**

To support mid-term investigators with unusual promise who have demonstrated a commitment to the cardiovascular or cerebrovascular science area as indicated by prior publication history and accomplishments.

### **Grant-in-Aid**

To encourage and adequately fund the most innovative and meritorious research projects from independent investigators.
