The 5th Annual Conference on Arteriosclerosis, Thrombosis, and Vascular Biology will be held at the Hilton San Francisco, May 6–8, 2004. The meeting is sponsored by the ATVB Council; the Council on Nutrition, Physical Activity and Metabolism; and the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. The conference will include special lectures, discussions, and oral and poster presentations. Plenary presentations will be made by leading investigators in a variety of fields, spanning platelet and vascular cell signaling, lipid trafficking and lipoprotein metabolism, atherosclerosis and thrombosis, obesity, extracellular matrix biology, and leukocyte biology and inflammation. Special events include the Irvine H. Page Young Investigator Research Award Competition, the Young Investigator Prizes in Thrombosis Competition, and the Jeffrey M. Hoeg Arteriosclerosis, Thrombosis, and Vascular Biology Award for Basic Science and Clinical Research Lecture. Junior investigators are particularly encouraged to attend this meeting, which has become a leading forum for scientific exchange between investigators from a wide variety of disciplines. Another meeting of interest to Council members in the Midwest is the 5th Annual Antithrombotic Symposium jointly sponsored by Wayne State University/Detroit

Medical Center, the Henry Ford Health System, and Loyola University. It will be held on Monday, March 29, 2004, at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Dearborn, Mich. The one-day meeting attracts over 600 attendees from 10 states and five Canadian provinces; its organizers are Council members as are many of its speakers. Topics covered by internationally recognized experts range from basic vascular biology and thrombosis through the clinical science and practical issues related to antithrombotic therapy in cardiology and other clinical specialties.

The program will feature Kenneth Mann, PhD, as the Eberhard Mammen Lecturer in Basic Science, and Samuel Z. Goldhaber, MD, as the Mammen Lecturer in Clinical Science. The meeting format includes a morning plenary session and “signature” afternoon breakout sessions focused on

topics in arterial disease, venous disease, and antithrombotic pharmacology. Additional featured speakers include Eric Bates, MD; Clifford Colwell, MD; James de Lemos, MD; Gregory Del Zoppo, MD; Jawed Fareed, PhD; James Ferguson, MD; Jeffrey Ginsberg, MD; Andra James, MD; Agnes Y. Lee, MD, MSc; Edith Nutescu, PharmD; and Albert L Waldo, MD. The symposium is open to physicians and scientists, pharmacologists, and nurses.
