



William M. Feinberg Award for Excellence in Clinical Stroke

The Stroke Council of the American Stroke Association (a division of the American Heart Association) is pleased to accept nominations for the Year 2001 William M. Feinberg Award for Excellence in Clinical Stroke

This award recognizes contributions to the investigation and management of stroke.

Criteria

The nominee **must** meet the following criteria to be considered for this award:

- Be a current fellow of the Stroke Council at the time of nomination
- Be actively engaged in ongoing research in clinical stroke
- Have made significant contributions to clinical research in stroke (including epidemiology, prevention, pathogenesis, diagnosis and treatment or other aspects of stroke.)
- Been active in programs of the Stroke Council
- Be nominated by a fellow or member of the Stroke Council

Those who have previously received this award or presented the Willis Lecture are not eligible for nomination.

Award

The winner of this prestigious award will deliver a lecture on stroke at the 26th International Stroke Conference, February 14-16, 2001 and receive:

- \$2,000 Honorarium plus expenses to attend the conference
- \$10,000 grant to the recipient's institution to support future stroke research

How to Nominate

You **must** personally inform your candidate that he/she has been nominated for this award and confirm their willingness to accept the award if selected. To nominate a candidate, please submit 6 copies each of the following:

- The candidate's curriculum vitae and bibliography
- A letter, which outlines the candidate's qualifications in clinical stroke and demonstrated excellence in clinical research

Deadline

Nominations for the Year 2001 Award **must be postmarked no later than August 1, 2000.**

Nominations postmarked after this date will not be accepted.
